Health and Safety Course attendance as a mandatory measure to draw down TAMSII Scheme Payments

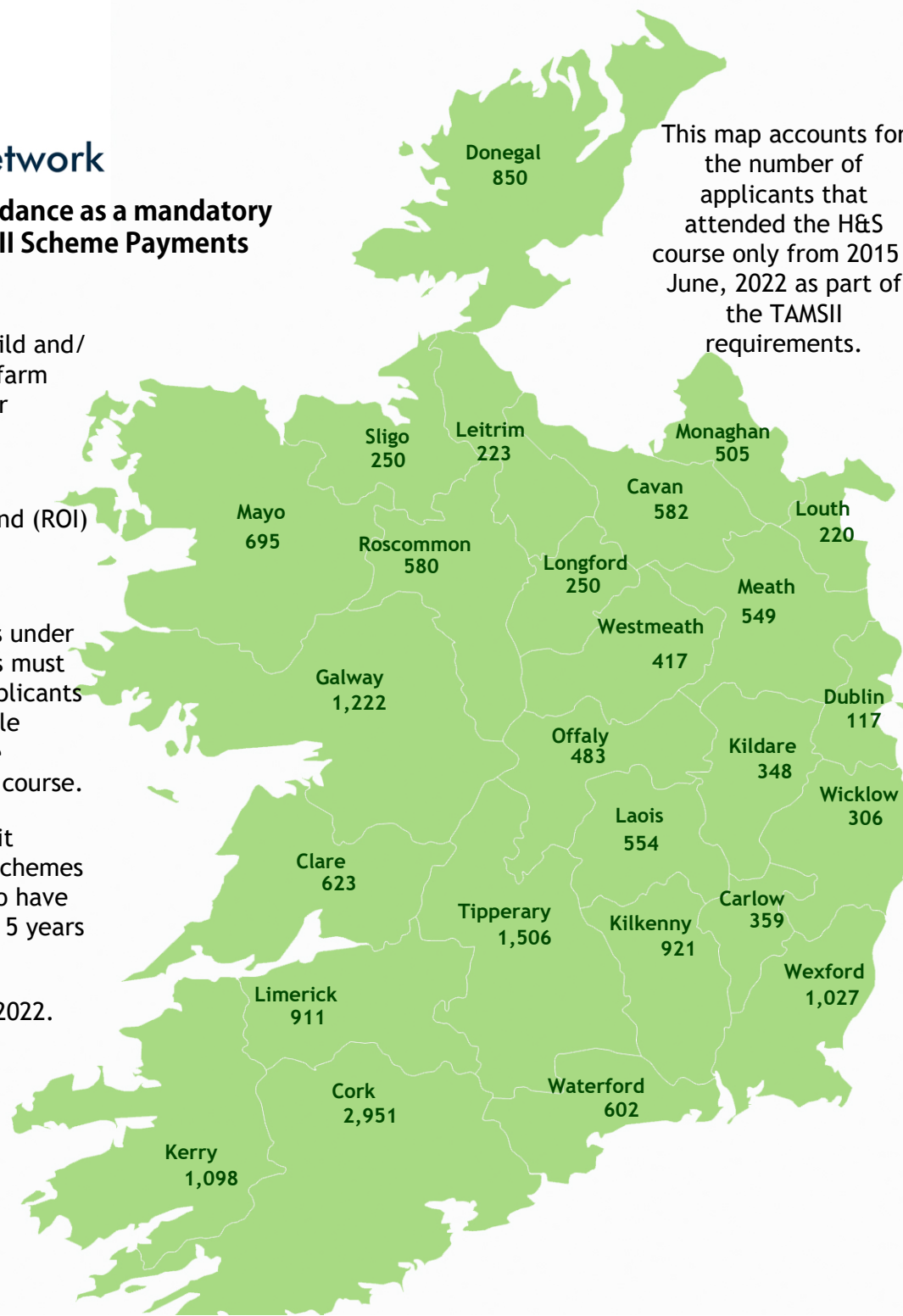
The Targeted Agriculture Modernisation Scheme (TAMSII) provides grants to farmers to build and/or improve a specified range of farm buildings and equipment on their holding.

TAMSII is an Agri-environmental measure in the Republic of Ireland (ROI) under the Rural Development Programme (2014-2022).

In order to draw-down payments under the TAMSII scheme all applicants must have completed H&S course. Applicants who completed a relevant eligible course, FETAC L6 or higher were exempt from attending the H&S course.

Note* One applicant could submit multiple applications since the schemes inception, but is only required to have attended one H&S course within 5 years of the applications being made.
