The Organic Farming Scheme (OFS) provides financial support to encourage production of organic foods.

Objective: OFS aims to deliver enhanced environmental and animal welfare benefits and to encourage producers to respond to the market demand for organically produced food.

The OFS is funded by the Rural Development Programme (RDP) 2014-2020 extended to 2022. There were four tranches of applications:

OFS Tranche 1: closed 29th May 2015

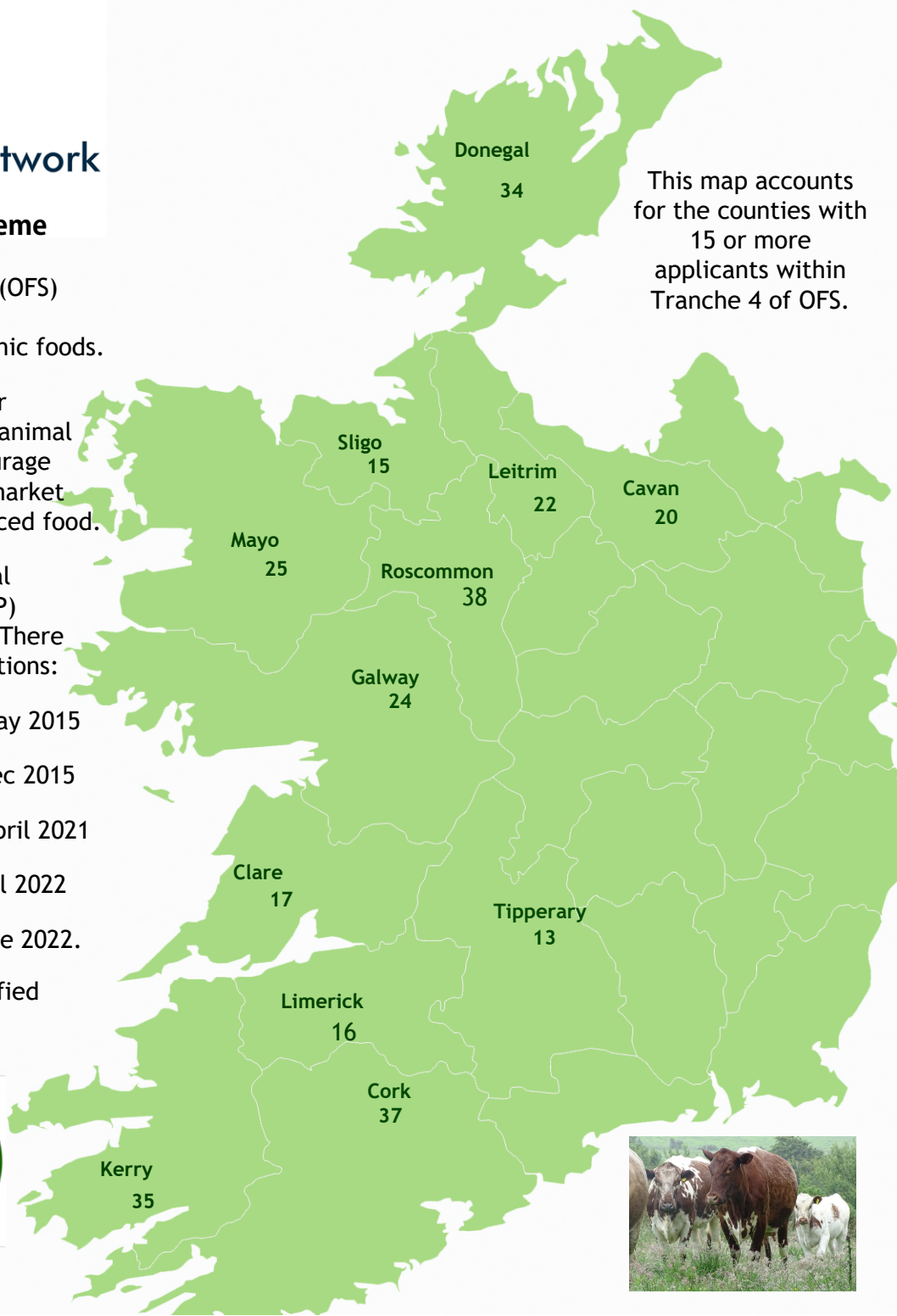
OFS Tranche 2: closed 31st Dec 2015
