

Agri-Climate Rural Environment Scheme (ACRES) – Co-operation 2023 Applications

Applicants eligible for the ACRES co-operation approach must be based in a high priority geographical area. The map and table illustrates the 8 co-operation project (CP) zones ands the uptake per county with a total of 18,618 applicants.



These CP zones include areas dominated by semi-natural vegetation (both privately owned and in commonage), Natura 2000 lands, and priority water catchments.

Participants in this approach of the scheme will work with local CP teams, who will direct the implementation of the scheme at local level.

The maximum payment is €10,500 a year with a maximum results-based payment of €7,000 with an extra non-productive investment and landscape action maximum of €3,500.
