

Agri-Climate Rural Environment Scheme (ACRES) 2023 Applications

ACRES, which forms part of Ireland's
Common Agricultural Policy (CAP)
Strategic Plan for the period 2023-2027,
has been designed to contribute
significantly to achieving improved
biodiversity, climate, air and water quality
outcomes, through both multi-functional
prescription and results-based actions.

An underlying principle of ACRES is the location of the right action in the right place to maximise and enhance the contribution of actions to these objectives.

ACRES is comprised of two approaches: General and Co-operation.

The map demonstrates the spread of the 46,230 total applicants per county received under Tranche 1, with Mayo, Galway and Donegal showing the highest levels of interest in the Scheme.
